Troubleshooting

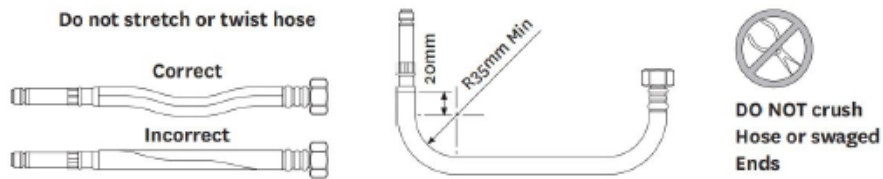
Symptom	Cause(s)	Resolution
No flow or low flow rate	Partially closed isolation valve	Open isolation valve
	Instantaneous water heater cycles on and off as flow rate or pressure is too low	Increase water flow rate or pressure through system.
	Air lock or partial blockage in the supply pipework or hoses	Flush through pipework to ensure removal of debris and any airlocks.
	Hot or cold water being drawn off elsewhere causing pressure changes or instantaneous boiler temperature changes.	Try not to use other water outlets when using the mixer
Water dripping from the mixer	This is normal for a short time after using the mixer	This is due to residual water tension, the build up of water in the tap body.
	If water continues to drip, possible issue with the flow control cartridge.	Please contact our customer care team.
Mixer does not turn on	Closed isolation valve	Open isolation valve
	Mains water supply turned off	Turn on mains water supply

Installation Requirements

Before commencing installation of the new product, ensure that the system has been flushed to remove any debris, which could cause damage to the valves and invalidate the warranty.

Installation

- 1, Fit the base ring onto the bottom of the tap body the raised edge of the base ring sits inside the lip on the base of the tap with the rubber washer facing the basin.
- 2, Insert the fixing bolt into the bottom of the tap, with the slot facing out and using a flat bladed screwdriver tighten this up.
- 3, Screw the flexible tails into the bottom of the tap, by hand, until tight. Do not use PTFE tape, or similar, on the threads.
- 4, Feed the tails and fixing bolt into the hole in the basin, ensuring that the base ring and rubber washer are seated correctly and fully covering the hole.
- 5, From the underside of the basin feed the rubber horseshoe shaped washer over the fixing bolt followed by the metal one. Place the nut over the fixing bolt and tighten until the tap is fixed on the basin. Do not over tighten.
- 6, Connect the hot and cold feeds to the water supply.
- 7, Reinstate the water supply and test for leaks.

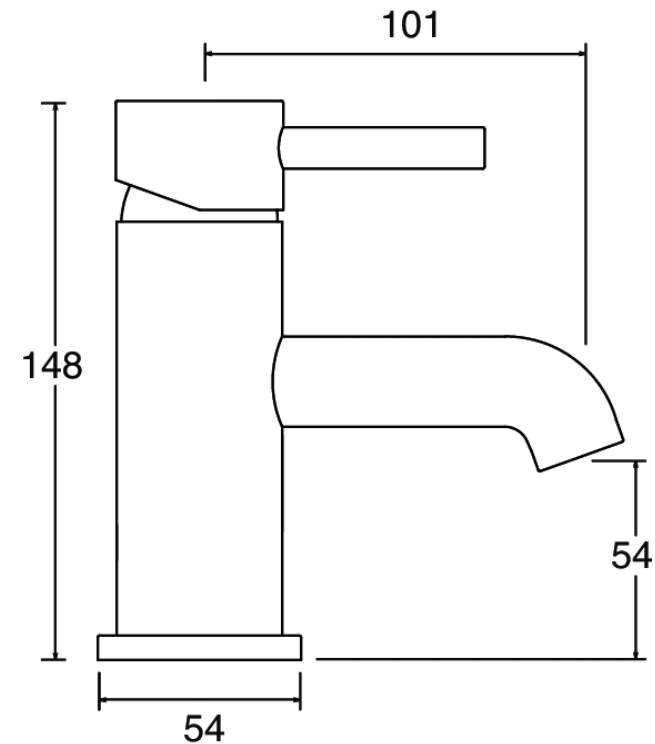
Remove all packaging and check the components for damage before starting installation.
